# SCHOLARSHIP SCHEME FOR 2022/23

Activate Learning is pleased to announce that we will be providing **three** scholarship awards to staff who wish to study on the **FdA Educational Practice** programme starting in September 2022.

The award will be £3,000 per year (£6,000 in total) towards the cost of your tuition fees.

To be eligible for a scholarship, you must meet all of the following criteria:

- Possess the qualifications and/or relevant experience to satisfy the entry requirements for the course
- Have the written support of your line manager
- Have a permanent contract of employment with Activate Learning
- Be from at least one of the following underrepresented groups:
- 1. Black, Asian or another ethnic minority group
- 2. Disabled (including mental, physical, or specific learning difficulty such as Dyslexia)
- 3. From a low participation neighbourhood (POLAR Quintile1 or 2)
- 4. Be resident at a postcode which is classified within EIMD 1 or 2

#### **APPLICATION PROCESS**

You will need to complete another application form following the submission of your official application via <u>UCAS</u>.

## THE DEADLINE FOR APPLYING IS 10 JUNE 2022.

All applications will first be assessed by a panel against the criteria listed above. They will also consider your personal statement and any other relevant information you provide.

If you are successful, you will be notified on the of 7 July 2022. If you are unsuccessful, you will also be notified on 7 July 2022 and be provided with advice and guidance as to what other support may be available to help you in your application and studies.

## **PLEASE NOTE:**

- No cash is given over to a member of staff, payment of partial fees of the course is made internally to cover the partial cost of the tuition fees for the 2022 programme.
- Please make sure that you add your UCAS application number onto the Microsoft form in order to complete your application to the scholarship programme.
- When completing your personal statement on the scholarship application form, you can upload a video of yourself telling us why you have applied for the scholarship rather than completing written statements.
- You are still eligible to apply for staff development funding through ALF of up to £1500 towards your course fees.
- We will interview all applicants that make our short list. After all the interviews are complete, we will confirm the names of the three scholars that will join the 2022 scholarship scheme.
